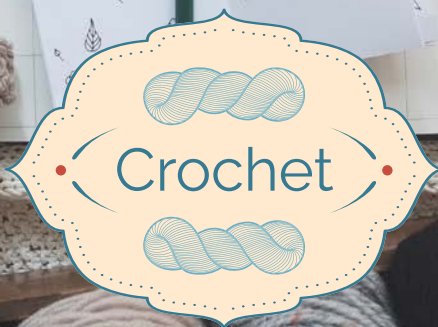


How to...



This is an intricate skill and can't be summed up in one page - but for those wanting to jump in and learn, here are the basics you need to get set up.

I would recommend attending a craft group where you can have hands on advice from the skilled and patient teachers who are willing to share this skill.



Everyone welcome to our crochet club held every Thursday at 2pm - 3pm.
Learners welcome. We have spare wool and spare crochet hooks and beginner patterns.

Depending on what you would like to make we can help you to become proficient at this craft.
If you bring your own wool (Double knit) you will require a 4.50mm - 5.00mm hook. If you have a project in mind bring that along too and we can get you started. We have several patient teachers to help teach you this and other crafts.

To begin, find a pattern you like, the library has plenty of pattern books in our non-fiction section.
So, make your starting chain.... however many you need. The pattern will tell you.

Follow the pattern which will tell you how to increase to change the shape and how to decrease to change shape and then cast off.
